



The Administrative building marks a transition between customs and traditions and the new realities of public administration within a First Nation community. Generous outdoor balconies help to integrate the interior and exterior spaces in an attempt to maintain the bond with the natural environment. A public gathering space for elders awaits off the main entrance, three conference rooms encourage group work and two staff lounges encourage harmony through socializing. The building's central feature space, the council chamber, provides ample area and inspiration for consensus building between all members of the First Nation.
