Kobayashi + Zedda Architects was retained by the French School Board in Whitehorse to create concepts for a major new addition to the existing K-12 french school in the Copper Ridge subdivision. The new building would contain community functions like library, performance centre and additional classrooms for adult education.

The Architect sought to create a new and intense urban experience within the wide open spaces of the existing school property. Street frontages were reinforced with strong building edges and internal courtyards and circulation were created in order to simulate an infill type development more commonly found in the historically rich urban environments of Quebec.
