



# HERITAGE

The MacBride Museum is an existing log museum and complex of heritage buildings in downtown Whitehorse. Expansion was required to house their extensive Yukon collection. The two storey museum addition was designed to historical proportions and scale and appears as a standalone building. The addition stands separate from the original buildings on site and makes use of the modern, yet historical corrugated siding.

The upper floor of the renovation also provides meeting and office space for the museum staff. The new MacBride addition integrates with the existing buildings on site creating a seamless historical complex.
