



Tantalus School is a kindergarten to grade 12 school, community hall, gymnasium and satellite campus of Yukon College located in Carmacks, Yukon. This 2,900 square metre wood frame school serves a small isolated community of 400 residents and is located 200 kilometres north of Whitehorse.



Home to the Little Salmon Carmacks First Nation, the Tantalus School is designed to meet the needs of the entire community and takes its shape from traditional pole structures found in the central Yukon. As the largest structure in town it serves many additional roles including a centre for community and first nation ceremonies, public library, disaster relief centre and recreation centre.
