



CONCEPTUAL DESIGN TRANSPORTATION MUSEUM

A 800 square metre addition and renovation was designed to meet the existing and future needs of the Transportation Museum. The addition is intended to improve the existing highway façade to attract vehicular traffic from the Alaska Highway. It features enlarged exhibit areas, and a dramatic new entry with water feature designed to create the sensation of motion and enforce the museum themes of land, water and sky. New exterior signage is supported on renovated steel rails.
