



WHITEHORSE GENERAL HOSPITAL RESIDENCE PROPOSAL

WHITEHORSE, YUKON

The proposed mixed use residence and office building were designed to take advantage of the incredible views available from the Whitehorse General Hospital Wickstrom Road property. The proposed building was designed as a part of a design-build process with Dominion Construction Ltd. Phasing of the project took into account the demolition of existing buildings, existing buried services and the extensive parking required.

The proposed building was designed to set the standard for future buildings on the WGH campus by being a model of sustainable northern design. The building was designed to meet a LEED Gold rating, including renewable energy components as part of building construction. Sustainable initiatives included ground water cooling, retention of rain water for irrigation, solar hot water, photo-voltaics panels and natural daylighting.
