



Completed in 1996, the 2,100 sq.m. Yukon Visitor Reception Centre provides a showcase facility for visitors to the Yukon. Located along the shores of the Yukon River downtown Whitehorse, a large component of the building provides office space for the Department of Tourism. The remainder is a state of the art visitor reception centre showcasing the natural and built attractions of the Yukon. The key design elements include a 150 seat theatre and a two-storey 700 sq.m. interpretive/display area. The building makes use of locally available building materials including Yukon fire killed logs and exterior wood siding.
