



YUKON SAWMILL BUILDING RENOVATION PLAN

Kobayashi + Zedda was retained by the Yukon Government in 1996 to prepare a research paper on the history of sawmills in the Klondike. Subsequent to the completion of the report, KZA was asked in 2005 to provide detailed construction documents toward the complete renovation of the building for use as an interpretive and administration centre. A portion of the work was completed in 2006 including an addition to the rear. The building, however, remains, unoccupied.
